**Guidance for Filling Preferences in Google form for  
Elective Postings**

**I. Instructions and Important information regarding Elective Postings:**

1. The revised Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, part II 2019 (GMER 2019) have created Elective Posting in the MBBS program providing students with an opportunity to gain immersive experience of a career stream, discipline, or research project. The opportunity to “work” in a clinical, laboratory, research, community set up or in a team-based setting at an early stage in the profession is an invaluable experience for students as this will have lasting impact on their professional life. It will be a Supervised, Experiential, Immersive and Self-directed learning experience.
2. Elective Posting includes two Blocks – Block 1 and Block 2.
  - Block 1 includes pre-/para - clinical disciplines or in other basic sciences laboratory or join ongoing research programs for Research experience in basic sciences or laboratory sciences. **During the Block 1 elective posting, regular clinical postings shall continue.**
  - Block 2 includes Clinical specialties or community clinics (rural or urban) for Explorative experience in patient care.
  - **Duration of posting for Block 1 and Block 2 shall be 15 days each.**
3. Each student must do **Compulsory Elective Postings for both Blocks.**
4. **Only Government Medical College Aurangabad candidates who have cleared Phase II MBBS are eligible for the Elective Postings.**
5. At the **end of the posting there will be assessment exam** and submission of **logbook** maintained during elective postings is required for **eligibility to appear in the final MBBS examination.**
6. Performance in Elective Postings will be contributed to **internal assessment.**

7. Instructions For Filling Preferences in Google forms for Elective Postings:

- All students shall fill following details: Name, Roll. No, Batch, Phone No. Email id, Marks in Phase II, Percentage in Phase II.
- Candidates then must fill their choices of Elective Posting in the order of their preference. Preferably, **eight (8) preferences** with the Name of Department and Elective module name. E.g. **Obstetrics And Gynecology - Adolescent health care.**
- Only one google form per student shall be accepted.
- **Last day for submission of google form for both electives is 5<sup>th</sup> March (Upto 5 PM)**

8. Allotment of elective posting will be done considering MBBS Phase II marks.
