### • Facilities for Students:

1. Clinical material- There are approximately 350 to 400 patients attending outpatient department daily and 70-75-patients get admitted daily under the department of Medicine. Speciality clinics- Neurology, cardiology, endocrine, gastroenterology, nephrology, geriatric OPD's are conducted every day and this facility is availed by large number of patients.

Infrastructure- Department of Medicine building is specially built comprising of three floors containing three male wards, three female wards, 12 bedded intensive cardiac care unit, 17 bedded Medical intensive care unit, 35 bedded infectious disease ward, a departmental laboratory, dedicated pharmacy unit, a lecture hall of capacity 250 students, a seminar hall of a capacity of 100 seats and well-furnished department of Medicine office. Nephrology and cardiology super specialty buildings.
