Historic Moment



The foundation stone of the present college building was laid down at the auspicious hands of Swami Ramanand Teerth who led the Marathwada Mukti Sangram; and the then Chief Minister of Maharashtra Shri Yeshwantrao Chavan on 27th October 1957.

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND:

Government Medical College and hospital, Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar (Aurangabad) is one of the premier Medical colleges in Maharashtra and the biggest tertiary care hospital for the whole Marathwada Region.

The Medical College and Hospital is commonly known as GHATI. The College was established in July- August 1956. It is situated in the heart of the city with an area of 99 acres of land.

On 15th August 1956, as whole of India celebrated the 10th Independence Day, Govt. Medical College, Aurangabad was established in the historic city of Aurangabad- Capital city of Marathwada. Marathwada itself got its freedom from Nizam state and became a part of independent India on 17th Sept. 1948.

The college started in historic Nizam Bungalow in cantonment area of the city with a modest student number of just 50. Initially infectious, obstetrics & ophthalmology wards were in a building at Amkhas.

The foundation stone of the present college building was laid down at the auspicious hands of Swami Ramanand Teerth who led the Marathwada Mukti Sangram; and the then Chief Minister of Maharashtra Shri Yashwantrao Chavan on 27th October 1957. The present complex of the College & Hospital building came up over a few years and presently this is spread in 30 buildings over 99 acres of land. New buildings with ultra-modern facilities for Medicine wards, CVTS, Nephrology & Cancer Institute are coming up.

- The hospital, which started with only 300 beds in 1960 is now catering to 1177 in-patients in various medical specialties
- Initially only 50 students were admitted for MBBS course, and they had to go to Nagpur for their 2nd & 3rd Year studies. The UG admission strength was increased to 100 per year, then to 150 per year & now it is 200 per Year.
- The first P.G. student passed in M.S. Anatomy in 1963, under the Osmania University, Hyderabad.
- First P.G. student at this college under Marathwada University, now Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad passed his M.D. (Medicine) in 1964.
- P.G. Courses in various departments offer P.G. Degree Courses, in all 200 intake per year covering all pre, para and Clinical departments.
- Super Specialty Courses are also available in Neonatology, Surgical oncology, Pediatric oncology, Gynecological oncology, onco pathology, medical oncology and Head neck surgery. The total intake is 25 seats covering all these courses.
- Other courses that are available are Paramedical, Nursing, Certificate courses, PG-DMLT, and Fellowship courses.
- Total intake 926 seats of above all courses per Year.

All above courses are affiliated with Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

Institute provides all tertiary care facilities for patients and all for facilities of a tertiary care hospital are available. The institute also provides all medicines to the patient and no prescription is given to the patients to procure drugs from outside.

Now, the institute has fully functional Super specialty Block catering services for all Super specialty services.

The Biggest boon to the people of Marathwada region will be “Government Cancer Hospital” a state of art hospital. It is a 300 bedded hospital and is providing State of the art facilities for Radiotherapy, Chemotherapy and Operative treatment to cancer patients. This cancer hospital will cater services to patients of Marathwada, Vidarbha & Khandesh. The first OSD since its inception is Dr Arvind Gaikwad.

Overall administrative Head of Medical College, Hospital, Cancer Hospital and Super specialty Block is Dean Dr Shivaji Sukre, under whose able leadership and innovative ideas the institute is providing the best academic atmosphere for Students and also for patient care services.
